A.G. -v- Denis Edmund Barbet

(Superior Number Appeal)

DEPUTY BAILIFF: We will treat the application for leave to appeal Mr. Cushen as in fact, the appeal itself and we have considered all the matters you have raised most carefully but the Court is unanimous - that is to say the Jurats are unanimous, and as I have said I have not taken a part except in the question of law in this matter - unanimous that the application does not succeed and that there was not that manifest injustice which would otherwise entitle you to succeed in this case. The Court accepts in fact, the arguments set out in the judgment of the learned Bailiff before giving the reasons that directed the Inferior Number to reach the conclusions they did and as I say, the appeal is dismissed and you have your legal aid costs.
