The Deputy Bailiff: The Court agrees with the conclusions and the Court will put you on probation for three years. We think that you need help, rather than punishment, and that you will receive that help from the Probation Services, and we hope that you will make the most of it. I would just remark that it seems to us a very strange faith, that it dismisses one from the congregation, just when one most needs help, but we hope that you get that help from the Probation Service instead.
