Bailiff: Allen the Court would wish there was something else the Court could do with you..... ..but we cannot say that the conclusions are wrong, there is nothing else we really can do. You are persisting in these type of offences and the public must be protected. You will go to prison for twelve months as asked for by the Attorney General in accordance with the conclusions and the binding over order will stand, so when you have finished the rest of your sentence you will go back to England.
