BAILIFF: Mr. Shori, your counsel hasn't opposed the conclusions. Nevertheless, I am constrained to say that the immigration officers here are indeed alert, as you found out, and thanks to their vigilance, cases like this, which are rare, fortunately, come to light. This Court must make it clear as it has in the past, that the Island cannot be used as a back door for immigration into the United Kingdom. The conclusions are granted, you are fined £1,000 or in default, 6 months, and you will pay £200 costs.
