REMAND FOR SENTENCING

DEPUTY BAILIFF: Dealing first with the accused McGurk. He is remanded for sentencing on October 26th at 10 a.m. He is remanded in custody. Having regard to the accused Gordon Gilbert McDonald, and having regard to the decision of the Jury, that differentiates between the two accused, and having regard to the term served by McDonald on remand, the Court feels that it is proper to allow bail. Therefore, he is remanded in custody with the alternative of providing bail in the sum of Two hundred pounds (£200) for his appearance on the 26th October at 10 a.m. for sentence. But there are conditions to that grant of bail and they are that he will report daily at 6 p.m. to the town Police Station, that he will make himself available to the probation service as required for completion of reports and that he will, through his Counsel supply an address where he can be contacted at all times for the same purpose.
