JUDG MENT

THE BAILIFF: Mr Salinger, we are unable to reduce the conclusions substantially as requested by your counsel, but because of the special circumstances in which you find yourself we have decided to make a slight reduction as a matter of clemency and really for no other reason. Therefore, so far as the offences for which you were put on probation, the Probation Order is cancelled and instead you will serve a total for those offences of nine

months. So far as this offence is concerned you will be sentenced to three months and you will serve a total of twelve months therefore, instead of fifteen.
