**JUDGMENT**

DEPUTY BAILIFF: The Court is of the unanimous opinion that a custodial sentence is essential in this case.

Even having regard to the Guernsey sentence the conclusions asked for by the Attorney General are in the opinion of the Court fully justified. Therefore the conclusions are granted. Le Cras, you are sentenced on count 1 to six months' imprisonment and on counts 2 to 14 inclusive to six months' imprisonment on each concurrent with each other but consecutive to the

sentence on count 1, thus making a total of twelve months' imprisonment, and the probation order of the 2nd December, 1986, is discharged.
