JUDGMENT

DEPUTY BAILIFF: The Court is happy to agree; we are sure that it is the best course for you, SW . Therefore, you are placed on probation for a period of three years on each count in the indictment, concurrently. In addition to the usual conditions that you will be of good behaviour and will live and work as directed by your Probation Officer, we add three special conditions: firstly, that you reside at Filey Avenue Probation Hostel for a period of up to six months and that you will abide by the rules of the hostel; secondly, that you will attend the hostel activity programme from Monday to Friday,

9.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m., for a period of up to sixty days, as directed by the warden of the hostel; thirdly, that you will otherwise reside as directed by the Probation Officer. You have been given a wonderful opportunity, now it's up to you.
