Breaking and entering with intent, possession of a controlled drug, contrary to Article 6(1) of the Misuse of Drugs (Jersey) Law, 1978 (3 Counts) and supplying a controlled drug, contrary to Article 5 of the Misuse of Drugs (Jersey) Law, 1978 (2 Counts).

Accused aged 17. Record of previous convictions (no drug-related offences). Accused assessed as suitable for entry to United Kingdom specialist hostel.

JUDGMENT

DEPUTY BAILIFF: KF, you are placed on probation in respect of each of Counts 1 to 6 of the present indictment concurrently; on probation for two years with a condition that for a minimum of six months and a maximum of one year you will reside at Mannachie House at the discretion of the Warden of the Hostel. There will be a further condition that you will attend at Cambourne Probation Centre at the

discretion of the Supervising Officer of that Centre in order to participate in an offending behaviour programme for a period not exceeding 60 days within the period of probation.

I should add that the Probation Order will also be subject to all the usual conditions because obviously the Probation Order will continue after your return from Mannachie House.

Therefore, you will be subject to the usual conditions that you will be of good behaviour throughout the two year period of the Probation Order and you will live and work where directed by your Probation Officer.

Furthermore the Court notes that should you respond satisfactorily to supervision you will be permitted to return to your parents' address under the supervision of the Jersey Probation Department from the 21st December of this year to the 2nd January, 1991.

The Court also orders that the Probation Orders of the 27th September, 1989, and the 23rd May, 1990, are discharged and we make an order for the forfeiture and destruction of any and all drugs recovered by the police from you.
