the Legitimacy (Jersey) Law, 1973, declaring the
child illegitimate.

the de facto father pay the reasonable costs of
the petitioner.

JUDGMENT

DEPUTY BAILIFF: Firstly, under Article 7/1 the Court makes a decree
to declare the child illegitimate.

Secondly, in the view of the Court there is some justice in
the application for costs; the mother and the de facto father

brought about the situation which gives rise to the application. Therefore, the Court orders that the mother and the de facto father shall pay the costs of the petitioner on a taxation basis, there being no exceptional circumstances to depart from the normal rules.
