JUDGMENT

THE BAILIFF: Smash and grab at night is a very serious offence. You, JP in particular, did it to feed your own need for drink. We cannot find that the conclusions are wrong. What they would have been if the hands of the Crown were not tied is another matter. I think you are both lucky that the hands of the Court are not tied in relation to offenders of your age.

BF you are sentenced to six months' imprisonment;
JP you are sentenced to twelve months' imprisonment.
