**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**The Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010**

*Made* - - - - *10th June 2010*

*Coming into operation* - *7th July 2010*

The Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 37(3), 37(4) and 38(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 5 to that Order.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 7th July 2010.

**Application of speed limits**

2. The driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 is prohibited.

3. The driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 is prohibited.

**Revocations**

4. The provisions described in Schedule 3 are revoked.

## SCHEDULE 1

Article 2

### Lengths of road subject to a speed limit of 40 mph

1. Leighan Road, Unclassified No. 8522, Derrygonnelly, Enniskillen, from its junction with Monea Road, Route B81, to a point 435 metres south-east of that junction.
2. Old Rossorry Road, Unclassified No. 6300, Enniskillen, from its junction with Derrylin Road, Route A509, to a point 545 metres north-east of that junction.
3. Barony Road, Route C612, Mountfield, from a point 510 metres east of its junction with Main Street, Route C612, to a point 850 metres east of that junction.
4. Glenariff Road, Route A43, Waterfoot, from its junction with Main Street, Route A2, to a point 640 metres south-west of that junction.

## SCHEDULE 2

Article 3

### Lengths of road subject to a speed limit of 50 mph

- 1.** Dublin Road, Route A4, Enniskillen, from a point 65 metres south of its northern junction with Lough Yoan Road, Unclassified No. 6513, to a point 916 metres south-east of that junction.
- 2.** Killadeas Road, Route B82, Enniskillen, from a point 207 metres north-west of its junction with Lettermoney Road, Unclassified No. 9628 to a point 150 metres south of its junction with Trory Lane, Unclassified No. 6850.
- 3.** Lisnagole Road, Route A34, Lisnaskea, from a point 195 metres north-west of its junction with Gola Road, Route B514, to a point 650 metres north-west of that junction.

Article 4

### Revocations

Items 372, 373 and 376 of Schedule 2 to the Roads (Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 1984<sup>(a)</sup>.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order—

- (a) applies a speed limit of 40 miles per hour to the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1;
- (b) applies a speed limit of 50 miles per hour to the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2;  
and
- (c) revokes the provisions in Schedule 3.

In relation to the revoked provisions in Schedule 3—

**1.** The speed limit on Killyclogher Road, Mountfield (item 372) is included in a longer length of road subject to a 30 miles per hour speed limit (restricted by street lighting).

**2.** The speed limit on Lenagh Road, Mountfield (item 373) is included in a longer length of road subject to a 30 miles per hour speed limit (restricted by street lighting).

**3.** Spring Road, Mountfield (item 376) is included in a longer length of road subject to a 30 miles per hour speed limit (restricted by street lighting).
