**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymoney)
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010**

Made - - - - - *16th August 2010*

Coming into operation - *7th September 2010*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymoney) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 7th September 2010.

Amendment

2. The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymoney) Order (Northern Ireland) 2008(d) shall be amended by the addition to Schedule 2 of the following item—

“9. John Street (south-east side) - from a point 15 metres north-east of its junction with Trinity Drive for a distance of 10 metres in a north-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballymoney) Order (Northern Ireland) 2008 (“the Order”) by the addition to Schedule 2 of the item specified in Article 2.

The Order prohibits vehicles waiting on the length of road specified in Article 2 at any time.

Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£60) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be erected on the road.
