**The Northwood, Lurgan (Footway) (Abandonment) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 2010**

*Made* - - - - *14th September 2010*

*Coming into operation* - *20th October 2010*

The Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes, on completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic, to abandon the area of road described in the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as The Northwood, Lurgan (Footway) (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 20th October 2010.

(2) In this Order “the Developer” means Mr E. Nelson whose address is 13 Northwood, Lurgan, Craigavon BT67 9HZ.

**Application**

**2.** The Developer shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on completion of the works the area of road described in the Schedule shall be abandoned.
