The Bog Road, Ballygowan (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010

Made - - - - *23rd September 2010*

Coming into operation - *10th November 2010*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes, on completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic, to abandon the area of road described in the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as The Bog Road, Ballygowan (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 10th November 2010.

(2) In this Order “the Contractor” means Northstone (NI) Ltd whose registered office is situated at 66 Ballybarnes Road, Newtownards, BT23 4UE.

Application

2. The Contractor shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on completion of the works the area of road described in the Schedule shall be abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road shall be relocated.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be extinguished.

Article 2

AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

An area of 84 square metres of road on the south side of the Bog Road, Ballygowan from a point 6 metres south-east of its junction with Carrickmannon Road in the townland of Carrickmannan and County Down, and more particularly delineated and shown hatched on Map No. 10/1/2/10.
