**ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

**The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles)  
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *26th October 2010*

*Coming into operation* - *17th November 2010*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide a suitable parking place for vehicles on the part of the road specified in Article 2.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking place the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

One objection has been received and subsequently withdrawn.

The Department has modified the Order to take account of the objection.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 17th November 2010.

## **Amendment**

**2.**—(1) The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006(a) shall be amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In Schedule 1, for item 250, substitute the following item—

“250. College Street, Belfast (north side) - from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Queen Street, for a distance of 24 metres.”.
