**The Durham Street and Hamill Street – Killen Street, Belfast
(Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012**

Made - - - - *16th May 2012*

Coming into operation - *4th July 2012*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1), (3) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that another road is available which provides alternative facilities for vehicular traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

Four written objections have been received and subsequently withdrawn.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Durham Street and Hamill Street – Killen Street, Belfast (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 and shall come into operation on 4th July 2012.

Application

2. The Department shall carry out such works as it considers necessary to prevent or restrict to such extent as the Department thinks fit, access by vehicular traffic to the roads described in the Schedule and the roads shall be stopped-up to vehicular traffic at the lines specified therein.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the roads to be stopped-up shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

SCHEDULE ROADS TO BE STOPPED UP

Article 2

1. Durham Street, Belfast at a line at its junction with College Square North more particularly delineated and marked A-B on Map No. 10/1/23/11.

2. Hamill Street – Killen Street, Belfast at a line at their junction with College Square North more particularly delineated and marked C-D on Map No. 10/1/23/11.

A copy of the map has been deposited at the Department's Roads Service offices, Headquarters, Room 213, Clarence Court, 10-18 Adelaide Street, Belfast, and Eastern Division, Hydebank, 4 Hospital Road, Belfast.
