**The Loading Bays and Parking Places on Roads (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2012**

Made - - - - - *30th May 2012*

Coming into operation - *20th June 2012*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the parts of the road specified in Article 3.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department, in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule has taken such other steps as appear to it reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Loading Bays and Parking Places on Roads (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 and shall come into operation on 20th June 2012.

Amendments

2. Schedule 1 to The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007(d) shall be amended by the deletion of item nos. 107 and 108 relating to Castle Street, Strabane.

3.—(1) The Loading Bays and Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2008(a) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order deletes two parking places relating to Castle Street, Strabane from Schedule 1 to The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007 (Article 2).

It also amends The Loading Bays and Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2008 (“the Order”) by adding these two parking places to Schedule 1 of the Order (Article 3(a)) and to Schedule 2 (Article 3(b)).

A penalty charge is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.
