**The Parking Places and Loading Bays on Roads (Londonderry)
(Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012**

Made - - - - - *19th September 2012*

Coming into operation - *11th October 2012*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule and in Article 3.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department, in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places and Loading Bays on Roads (Londonderry) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 and shall come into operation on 11th October 2012.

Amendments

2. Schedule 1 to The Parking Places and Loading Bay on Roads (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2008^(d) shall be amended by the addition of the items specified in the Schedule to this Order.

3. Schedule 2 to The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007(a) shall be amended by the addition of the following items—

“51. Queens Quay, Londonderry (north side) – from a point 37.5 metres east of its junction with Police Court Street for a distance of 17 metres in a easterly direction.	8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.	Monday to Saturday inclusive
52. Strand Road, Londonderry (south side) – from a point 6 metres east of its junction with Great James Street for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction.	8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.	Monday to Saturday inclusive
53. Spencer Road, Londonderry (east side) from a point 16 metres south of its junction with Dungiven Road for a distance of 16 metres in a southerly direction.	8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.	Monday to Saturday inclusive”

SCHEDULE

Article 2

Parking Places — Monday to Saturday 8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. — Maximum stay 1 hour; No return within 1 hour

- “9. Queens Quay, Londonderry (north side) from a point 9.5 metres east of its junction with Police Court Street for a distance of 28 metres in an easterly direction.
10. Strand Road, Londonderry (north side) from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Foyle Embankment for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction.
11. Strand Road, Londonderry (south side) from a point 20 metres east of its junction with Foyle Embankment for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places and Loading Bay on Roads (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2008 by the addition to Schedule 1 of the items specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Order also amends The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007 by the addition to Schedule 2 of the items specified in Article 3. The loading bays are for the use of goods vehicles loading and unloading certain goods during the hours between 8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the roads.
