**Superannuation (Chief Inspector of Criminal Justice in Northern  
Ireland) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012**

*Made* - - - - - *17th February 2012*

*Coming into operation* - - - - - *14th March 2012*

The Department of Finance and Personnel makes the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 3(4) and (7) of the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972<sup>(a)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(b)</sup>.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Chief Inspector of Criminal Justice in Northern Ireland) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012, and shall come into operation on 14th March 2012.

**Addition to list of offices**

2. There shall be added to the offices listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation (Northern Ireland) Order 1972 with effect from 1st February 2012, the office of Chief Inspector of Criminal Justice in Northern Ireland<sup>(c)</sup>.
