**The Parking Places and Loading Bays on Roads (Londonderry)
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012**

Made - - - - *1st March 2012*

Coming into operation - *22nd March 2012*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule and in Article 3.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department, in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places and Loading Bays on Roads (Londonderry) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 and shall come into operation on 22nd March 2012.

Amendments

2. Schedule 1 to The Parking Places and Loading Bay on Roads (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2008^(d) shall be amended by the addition of the items specified in the Schedule to this Order.

3. Schedule 1 to The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007(a) shall be amended by the addition of the following items—

“110. Queens Quay, Londonderry (west side) – from a point 58 metres north of its junction with Lower Clarendon Street for a distance of 16 metres in a northerly direction.	8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.	Monday to Saturday inclusive
111. Queens Quay, Londonderry (west side) – from a point 12 metres south of its junction with Boating Club Lane for a distance of 67 metres in a southerly direction.	8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.	Monday to Saturday inclusive”

SCHEDULE

Article 2

Parking Places — Monday to Saturday 8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. — Maximum stay 1 hour; No return within 1 hour

- “6. Queens Quay, Londonderry (west side) – from a point 14 metres north of its junction with Lower Clarendon Street for a distance of 40 metres in a northerly direction.
7. Queens Quay, Londonderry (west side) – from a point 74 metres north of its junction with Lower Clarendon Street for a distance of 25 metres in a northerly direction.
8. Queens Quay, Londonderry (west side) – from a point 108 metres north of its junction with Lower Clarendon Street for a distance of 12 metres in a northerly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places and Loading Bay on Roads (Londonderry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2008 by the addition to Schedule 1 of the items specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Order also amends The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007 by the addition to Schedule 1 of the items specified in Article 3. The loading bays are for the use of all vehicles loading and unloading certain goods during the hours between 8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive.

A penalty charge (£60) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
