**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment
No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013**

Made - - - - - *8th April 2013*

Coming into operation - *29th April 2013*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedules.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

One objection has been received and duly considered and no other representations were received.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 29th April 2013.

Amendments

2.—(1) The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006(a) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In Schedule 1—

- (a) add the items set out in Schedule 1 to this Order; and
- (b) delete the following items—
 - (i) item no. 656 relating to Church Street, Ballynahinch;
 - (ii) item no. 237 relating to William Street, Donaghadee;
 - (iii) item no. 329 relating to William Street, Donaghadee; and
 - (iv) item no. 108 relating to Second Avenue, Derrybeg Park, Newry.

(3) In Schedule 3—

- (a) add the items set out in Schedule 2 to this Order; and
- (b) delete item no. 1 relating to Castle Street, Carrickfergus.

3.—(1) Schedule 1 to The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006(b) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) Delete the following items—

- (a) item no. 412 relating to High Street, Carrickfergus;
- (b) item no. 580 relating to William Street, Donaghadee;
- (c) item no. 607 relating to Edward Street, Downpatrick;
- (d) item no. 764 relating to Kinnegar Road, Holywood;
- (e) item no. 804 relating to Rooney Park, Kilkeel; and
- (f) item no. 1082 relating to Dominic Street, Newry.

(3) For item no. 745 substitute the following item—

“Main Street, Greyabbey, (south-east side) – from a point 181 metres north-east of its junction with The Square, for a distance of 5.5 metres.”

Article 2 (2)

Unlimited Waiting

- “922. Ganaway Avenue, Bangor (south-east side) – from a point 66.5 metres south-west of its junction with Owenroe Drive, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
923. Holborn Avenue, Bangor (west side) - from a point 45.8 metres north-west of its junction with Crosby Street, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a north-westerly direction.
924. Prospect Road, Bangor (west side) – from a point 20 metres south of its junction with Beatrice Road, for a distance of 5.1 metres in a southerly direction.
925. North Parade, Belfast (north side) – from a point 69 metres east of its junction with Cross Parade, for a distance of 6.6 metres in an easterly direction.
926. Oceanic Avenue, Belfast (north side) – from a point 15 metres east of its junction with Antrim Road, for a distance of 6.6 metres in an easterly direction.
927. Witham Street, Belfast (east side) – from a point 56 metres north-east of its junction with Newtownards Road, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.
928. Houston Park, Broughshane (west side) – from a point 123 metres south of its junction with Knockan Road, for a distance of 3 metres in a southerly direction.
929. Moykeeran Drive, Draperstown (north side) – from a point 120 metres north of its junction with Moykeeran Crescent, for a distance of 6.5 metres in a northerly direction.
930. Cherryhill Gardens, Dundonald (south side) – from a point 29.3 metres west of its junction with Cherryhill Park, for a distance of 6 metres in a westerly direction.
931. Cleenish Park, Unclassified No. 6311 Stretch 3, Enniskillen (north-west side) – from a point 80 metres south-west of its junction with Cleenish Park, Unclassified No. 6311 Stretch 1, for a distance of 3 metres in a south-westerly direction.
932. Downshire Road, Holywood (north-east side) – from a point 73 metres north-west of its junction with Quinville, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
933. Station Road, Larne (north-east side) – from a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with Circular Road, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
934. First Avenue, Derrybeg Park, Newry (south side) – from a point 122 metres south of its junction with Second Avenue, for a distance of 3.7 metres in a north-easterly direction.
935. Donaghadee Road, Newtownards (north-west side) – from a point 33 metres north-east of its junction with Bangor Road, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
936. Frances Street, Newtownards (north side) – from a point 77 metres east of its junction with Windmill Row, for a distance of 6 metres in an easterly direction.
937. Patton Grove, Finlays Road, Newtownards (west side in a lay-by) – from a point 119 metres south-west of its junction with Bowtown Road, for a distance of 4.8 metres in a south-westerly direction.
938. Shackleton Walk, West Winds, Newtownards (east side) – from a point 93 metres north-east of its junction with Blenheim Drive, for a distance of 4.8 metres in an easterly direction.
939. Trasnagh Drive, Newtownards (north side) – from a point 80 metres west of its junction with Craiglee Way, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction.
940. Kennedy Street, Strabane (in a lay-by on the south-east side) – from a point 14 metres south-west of its junction with Barrack Street, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.”

SCHEDULE 2

Article 2 (3)

Waiting limited to 2 hours Monday to Saturday between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. with no return within 2 hours

- “6. Castle Street, Carrickfergus (north-west side) – from a point 34 metres north-east of its junction with A2 Marine Highway, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a north-easterly direction.
7. High Street, Carrickfergus (north-west side) – from a point 94 metres south-west of its junction with Antrim Street, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
8. High Street, Carrickfergus (south-east side) – from a point 61 metres south-west of its junction with Antrim Street, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
9. High Street, Carrickfergus (south-east side) – from a point 44 metres south-west of its junction with Antrim Street, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006 and The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the road specified in Schedule 1, the introduction of parking places with waiting limited to 2 hours on Monday to Saturday between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. with no return permitted within 2 hours on the lengths of the road specified in Schedule 2, the removal of the parking places referred to in Articles 2(2)(b), 2(3)(b) and 3(2), and the amendment of the item referred to in Article 3(3).
