ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

The Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014

Made - - - - *18th June 2014*

Coming into operation - *8th July 2014*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 37(3), 37(4) and 38(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 5 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 8th July 2014.

Speed restriction on certain roads

2. The Department directs that each of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 shall be a restricted road.

Application of speed limits

3. The driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the roads specified in Schedule 2 is prohibited.

4. The driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 is prohibited.

5. The driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 is prohibited.

SCHEDULE 1

Article 2

Restricted lengths of road

1. Archill Road, Unclassified No. 0118, Drumlegagh, Strabane, from its junction with the Drumlegagh Church Road, Route C0680, to a point 380 metres west of that junction.
2. Lough Road, Unclassified No. 0227, Drumlegagh, Strabane, from its junction with the Drumlegagh Church Road, Route C0680, to a point 230 metres south-east of that junction.
3. Shore Road, Route A2, Larne, from a point 18 metres north-west of its junction with Craiganboy Park, Unclassified No. 150, to a point 482 metres south-east of that junction.

SCHEDULE 2

Article 3

Roads subject to a speed limit of 20 miles per hour

1. Maloon Drive, Unclassified No. 5003, Cookstown.
2. Lissadell Drive, Unclassified No. 5307, Magherafelt.
3. Mullaghboy Crescent, Unclassified No. 5307, Magherafelt.
4. Mullaghboy Glen, Unclassified No. 5307, Magherafelt.
5. Mullaghboy Heights, Unclassified No. 5307, Magherafelt.
6. Mullaghboy Lane, Unclassified No. 5179, Magherafelt.

SCHEDULE 3

Article 4

Lengths of road subject to a speed limit of 40 miles per hour

1. Dunmurry Lane, Route C3, Belfast, from a point 274 metres east of its junction with Kingsway, Route A1, to its junction with Upper Malone Road, Route B23.
2. Drumahoe Road, Route B148, Larne, from a point 60 metres north-west of its junction with Old Mill Heights, Unclassified No. 140, to a point 406 metres north-west of that junction.
3. Aughrim Road, Route C0560, Magherafelt, from a point 175 metres west of its junction with Derrygarve Road, Unclassified No. 5127, to a point 900 metres west of that junction.
4. Lurgan Road, Route A3, Magheralin, Craigavon, from its junction with Newforge Road, Route B9, to a point 380 metres north-east of that junction.
5. Dungannon Road, Route A4, Portadown, from a point 21 metres north-west of its junction with Ballyoran Hill, Route C0161, to a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with Drumcree Road, Route C0162.

6. Madden Road, Route A51, Tandragee, from a point 480 metres north-east of its junction with Market Street Route A27, to a point 50 metres north-east of its junction with Tullyhugh Park, Unclassified No. 7825.

SCHEDULE 4

Article 5

Lengths of road subject to a speed limit of 50 miles per hour

1. Ballyutoag Road, Route A52, Belfast, from its junction with Crumlin Road, Route A52, for a distance of 1.45 kilometres in a north-westerly direction.

2. Crumlin Road, Route A52, Belfast, from a point 67 metres west of its junction with Upper Hightown Road, Route B95, for a distance of 1.93 kilometres in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Ballyutoag Road, Route A52.

3. White Brae, Unclassified No. 0214, Belfast, from its junction with Crumlin Road, Route A52, for a distance of 40 metres in a south-westerly direction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order—

- (a) makes the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 restricted roads;
- (b) applies a speed limit of 20 miles per hour to the roads specified in Schedule 2;
- (c) applies a speed limit of 40 miles per hour to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3;
- (d) applies a speed limit of 50 miles per hour to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4;
and
- (e) revokes the provisions in Schedule 5.

In relation to the revoked provisions in Schedule 5—

1. The speed limit on the lengths of Dunmurry Lane, Dunmurry, Belfast (paragraphs 1 and 6 of Schedule 5) is now set at 40 miles per hour.

2. The speed limit on Mullaghboy Crescent and Mullaghboy Lane, Magherafelt, (paragraph 2 of Schedule 5) is now 20 miles per hour.

3. The speed limit on the length of Dungannon Road, Portadown (paragraph 3 of Schedule 5) is now included in a longer length of road set at 40 miles per hour.

4. The speed limit on Lissadell Drive, Magherafelt, (paragraph 4 of Schedule 5) is now 20 miles per hour.

5. The speed limit on the length of Lurgan Road, Magheralin, Craigavon, (paragraph 5 of Schedule 5) is now included in a longer length of road set at 40 miles per hour.
