**The Lower Galliagh Road, Londonderry (Abandonment) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 2014**

*Made* - - - - - *2nd July 2014*

*Coming into operation* - *8th October 2014*

The Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes to abandon the length of road described in the Schedule as it is not necessary.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Lower Galliagh Road, Londonderry (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 8th October 2014.

**Application**

2. The length of road described in the Schedule is abandoned.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned length of road shall be removed.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be extinguished.

### LENGTH OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

A length of 686 metres of road at Lower Galliagh Road, Londonderry, extending in a south-westerly direction from its junction with Skeoge Link Road, more particularly delineated and shown hatched and coloured red on Map No. DR1/14/26282.
