**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Omagh) (Amendment  
No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014**

*Made* - - - - - *30th September 2014*

*Coming into operation* - - - - - *21st October 2014*

The Department for Regional Development<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Omagh) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 21st October 2014.

**Amendment**

2. The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Omagh) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013<sup>(d)</sup> is amended by the addition to Schedule 3 of the following item —

“17. Harmony Heights (west side) – from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Derry Road for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.”

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Omagh) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 (“the Order”) by the addition to Schedule 3 to that Order of the item in Article 2.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
