ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**The Loading Bays and Parking Places on Roads (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2014**

Made - - - - - *15th January 2014*

Coming into operation - *5th February 2014*

The Department for Regional Development(**a**) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(**b**) and now vested in it(**c**).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the parts of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department, in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Loading Bays and Parking Places on Roads (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 5th February 2014.

Amendment

2.—(1) The Loading Bays and Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2008((a) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) For Article 9(1) substitute the following—

“9.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) and save as provided in Article 10, during the specified hours—

- (a) (i) a person shall not leave or cause a vehicle to be left in a parking place for longer than 1 hour in the parking places listed in Part 1 of Schedule 1;
- (ii) a person shall not leave or cause a vehicle to be left in a parking place for longer than 2 hours in the parking places listed in Part 2 of Schedule 1.
- (b) a person shall not leave or cause that vehicle to be left again in that parking place, until the expiration of 1 hour from the time that vehicle is removed from that parking place.”

(3) For Schedule 1 substitute the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Loading Bays and Parking Places on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2008 (“the 2008 Order”) by applying a 2 hour restriction on waiting for those items set out in the new Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the 2008 Order.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the 2008 Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.
