ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) Order (Northern Ireland)
2015**

Made - - - - - *26th November 2015*

Coming into operation - *16th December 2015*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 and shall come into operation on 16th December 2015.

(2) In this Order—

“specified road” means the carriageway of a length of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 or column 1 of Schedule 2.

Prohibition of waiting

2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit a vehicle to wait wholly or partly in a specified road—

- (a) during the hours and on the days specified in columns 2 and 3 respectively of Schedule 1;
or
- (b) during the hours and on the days and dates specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 respectively of Schedule 2.

Exceptions

3. The prohibition in Article 2 shall not render it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to stop in a specified road so far as such stopping is reasonably necessary for the avoidance of an accident or to enable the vehicle to be used—

- (a) for police, military, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes;
- (b) in the services of the Department or a district council in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) in connection with the supply of electricity or gas or any telegraphic line; or
- (d) in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic.

Revocations

4. The Orders specified in Schedule 3 are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits waiting by vehicles, with certain exceptions, on lengths of Glenvale Park, Glynn, at the times and on the days and during the period specified in items 13 and 14 of Schedule 2.

The order also revokes and re-enacts the prohibitions contained in the provisions of the Orders specified in Schedule 3.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of this Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
