**The Agriculture (Student fees)(Amendment)  
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2016**

*Made* - - - - *22nd February 2016*

*Coming into operation* *1st September 2016*

The Department of Agriculture and Rural Development<sup>(1)</sup>, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 5A(1) and (2) of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland) 1949<sup>(2)</sup>, makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agriculture (Student fees)(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on the 1st September 2016.

**Amendment to the Agriculture (Student fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007**

2. The Agriculture (Student fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007<sup>(3)</sup> shall be amended as provided by regulations 3 and 4.

3. In regulation 4 (1)(4) for “£1,510” substitute “£1,555”:

4. In regulation 5(2)(5) for “£740” substitute “£760”.
