ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2017**

Made - - - - - *28th February 2017*

Coming into operation - *22nd March 2017*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

One objection has been received and duly considered.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 and shall come into operation on 22nd March 2017.

 - (ii) item no. 485 relating to Knockwood Grove, Belfast.
- (b) add the items set out in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Article 2(2)(b)

Unlimited Waiting

- “2375. Caulside Park, Antrim (east side) – from a point 325 metres north-east of its junction with Newpark Road South, for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction.
2376. Ballarat Street, Belfast (north side) – from a point 99 metres west of its junction with Ravenhill Road, for a distance of 6 metres in a westerly direction.
2377. Black’s Road, Belfast (west side) – from a point 20 metres north of its junction with Donegore Gardens, for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction.
2378. Black’s Road, Belfast (west side) – from a point 33 metres north of its junction with Donegore Gardens, for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction.
2379. Dunvegan Street, Belfast (north side) – from a point 81 metres west of its junction with Ravenhill Road, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction.
2380. Enid Drive, Belfast (south-west side) – from a point 33 metres south-east of its junction with Holland Drive, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
2381. Faburn Park, Belfast (north-west side) – from a point 58 metres west of its junction with Ballysillan Road, for a distance of 5.5 metres in south-westerly direction.
2382. Mount Merrion Avenue, Belfast (north-west side) – from a point 170 metres north-east of its junction with Hughes Court, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a north-easterly direction.
2383. Warren Grove, Belfast (south-east side) – from a point 159 metres north-east of its junction with Ravenswood Park, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2384. Grainan Drive, Londonderry (south side) – from a point 60 metres south-west and then south-east of its junction with Summerhill Park, for a distance of 6 metres in a south-easterly direction.
2385. Infirmary Road, Londonderry (north-west side) – from a point 30 metres north-east of its junction with Creggan Road, for a distance of 6 metres in a north-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 by the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule and the removal of parking places referred to in Article 2(2)(a).
