**The Loading Bays on Roads (Amendment) Order (Northern
Ireland) 2019**

Made - - - - - *9th September 2019*

Coming into operation - *30th September 2019*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in Article 2.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Loading Bays on Roads (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 30th September 2019.

“172.	Linenhall Street, Londonderry (south-east side) – from a point 15 metres north-east of its junction with Ferryquay Street for a distance of 11.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.	8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.	Monday to Saturday inclusive
173.	Strand Road, Londonderry (west side) – from a point 17 metres south-west of its junction with Rock Terrace for a distance of 16 metres in a south-westerly direction.	8.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.	Monday to Saturday inclusive”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Loading Bays on Roads Order (Northern Ireland) 2007 (“the Order”) by the addition to Schedule 1 of two loading bays for the use of all vehicles loading and unloading certain goods during the hours between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Monday to Saturday inclusive (Article 2).

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with The Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the roads.
