**The Footpaths (Centre Walk, Cherry Path and Lakeside Walk)
Craigavon (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019**

Made - - - - *1st May 2019*

Coming into operation - *27th May 2019*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes on the completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic to abandon the lengths of road described in the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as The Footpaths (Centre Walk, Cherry Path and Lakeside Walk) Craigavon (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 27th May 2019.

(2) In this Order “the Contractor” means Farrans Construction whose registered office is situated at 99 Kingsway, Dunmurry, Belfast, BT17 9NU.

Application

2. The Contractor shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on completion of the works the lengths of road described in the Schedule shall be abandoned.

3. All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned lengths of road shall be removed.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

LENGTHS OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

198.6 metres of road comprising 3 lengths of footpath at the former Craigavon Watersports Centre adjacent to Craigavon Southern Lake consisting of the following—

- (i) 107 metres of Centre Walk footpath extending in a south-westerly direction from its junction with Cherry Path footpath;
- (ii) 60.2 metres of Cherry Path footpath extending in a south-easterly direction from its junction with Centre Walk footpath; and
- (iii) 31.4 metres of Lakeside Walk footpath extending in a north-westerly direction from its junction with Centre Walk footpath.
