ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2021**

Made - - - - - *3rd February 2021*

Coming into operation - *24th February 2021*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representations has been received.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 24th February 2021.

“2858.	Edenvale Park, Antrim (south-west side of a parking area) – from a point 62 metres south-east and then south-west of its junction with Seacash Drive for a distance of 3 metres in a south-easterly direction.
2859.	Kilbride Gardens, Antrim (north side in a parking area in front of a grassed area to the front of No. 11b) – from a point 52 metres west of its junction with Donegore Drive for a distance of 3 metres in a westerly direction.
2860.	Coronation Park, Aughnacloy (south-east side in a lay-by to the side of No. 20) – from a point 32 metres south-west of its junction with Mill Street for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2861.	Andersonstown Park South, Belfast (south-east side) – from a point 54 metres north-east of its junction with Andersonstown Grove for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.
2862.	Bloomfield Crescent, Belfast (south-west side) – from a point 35 metres north-west of its junction with Bloomfield Parade for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
2863.	Cliftonville Road, Belfast (south-west side in a lay-by) – from a point 20 metres north-west of its junction with Elimgrove Street for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
2864.	Clonduff Drive, Belfast (north side) – from a point 26 metres west of its junction with Carney Crescent for a distance of 6 metres in a westerly direction.
2865.	Farnham Street, Belfast (north-west side) – from a point 89 metres north-east of its junction with Ormeau Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.
2866.	Glantane Drive, Belfast (west side) – from a point 27 metres south of its junction with Skegoneill Avenue for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction.
2867.	Glenbank Place, Belfast (south-east side) – from a point 43 metres south-west of its junction with Leroy Street for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2868.	Grays Park, Belfast (east side in a parking area) – from a point 18 metres north of its junction with Minnowburn Gardens for a distance of 3 metres in a northerly direction.
2869.	Greenville Road, Belfast (north-east side) – from a point 53 metres south-east of its junction with Beersbridge Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
2870.	Ulsterdale Street, Belfast (north-west side) – from a point 52 metres north-east of its junction with Bloomfield Avenue for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.
2871.	Castleview Terrace, Killeter Road, Castlederg (north-west side) – from a point 153 metres north-east of its western junction with Alexander Park for a distance of 6 metres in a north-easterly direction.
2872.	Market Square, Dromore, County Down, (south side) – from a point 22 metres east of its junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 3 metres in an easterly direction.
2873.	Princes Gardens, Larne (east side) – from a point 87 metres north-west of its junction with Glenarm Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a northerly direction.
2874.	Wellington Avenue, Larne (south side in a lay-by) – from a point 98 metres east of its junction with Wellington Parade for a distance of 5.5 metres in an easterly direction.
2875.	Iniscarn Park, Lisburn (north-west side in a parking area in front of No. 10b) – from a point 90 metres south-west of its junction with Causeway End Road for a distance of 3 metres in a south-westerly direction.

2876.	Redpoll Avenue, Lisburn (south-east side) – from a point 87 metres south-west of its junction with Finch Gardens for a distance of 6.6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2877.	Ballyvesey Court, Newtownabbey (south-east side) – from a point 60 metres south-east of its junction with Ballyvesey Park for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.
2878.	Rathmore Drive, Newtownabbey (north side) – from a point 99 metres west of its junction with Carmeen Drive for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction.
2879.	Main Street, Saintfield (south side in a lay-by) – from a point 11 metres west of its junction with Downpatrick Street for a distance of 6 metres in a westerly direction.
2880.	Crossgar Road, Shrigley (north side in a lay-by) – from a point 23 metres west of its western junction with Osborne Drive for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction.
2881.	Ransevyn Drive, Whitehead (east side in a parking area) – from a point 51 metres north of its junction with Islandmagee Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a north-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons’ Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule and the removal of the parking places referred to in Article 2(2).
