**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) (Amendment
No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021**

Made - - - - - *5th July 2021*

Coming into operation - - - - - *30th July 2021*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

Six objections have been received and duly considered and no other representations have been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 30th July 2021.

Amendment

2. The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018^(d) is amended by the addition to Part 2 of Schedule 2 of the following item—

“164. Adelaide Park (north side) – from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Malone Road for a distance of 74 metres in a westerly direction.”

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018 (“the Order”) by the addition to Part 2 of Schedule 2 of the item specified in Article 2 to this Order.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
