**The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) (Amendment No. 2) Order  
(Northern Ireland) 2021**

*Made* - - - - - *22nd September 2021*

*Coming into operation* - *13th October 2021*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 13th October 2021.

**Amendment**

2. The Prohibition of Waiting (Schools) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021<sup>(d)</sup> is amended by the addition to Schedule 1 of the following item—

“10.	Quay Road, Ballycastle (south-east side) – from a point 145 metres south-west of its junction with Mary Street for a distance of 30 metres in a south-westerly direction.	8.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.	Monday to Saturday inclusive”

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*
