**The Plantation Mews, Lisburn (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022**

*Made* - - - - - *27th October 2022*

*Coming into operation* - *6th December 2022*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes on completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic to abandon the area of road described in the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

One objection was received and duly considered.

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Plantation Mews, Lisburn (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2022 and shall come into operation on 6th December 2022.

(2) In this Order “the Contractor” means WGK Homes Limited whose registered office is situated at 172 Ballymoney Road, Banbridge, Co. Down, BT32 4HW.

**Application**

**2.** The Contractor shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on completion of works the area of road described in the Schedule shall be abandoned.

**3.**—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

Article 2

### AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED
