**The U8133 (unnamed road) off Friary Road, Newtownhamilton  
(Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024**

*Made* - - - - - *26th June 2024*

*Coming into operation* - - - - - *3rd October 2024*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) and (5) of The Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes on the completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic to abandon the area of road described in the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

One objection was received and duly considered.

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the U8133 (unnamed road) off Friary Road, Newtownhamilton (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024 and shall come into operation on 3rd October 2024.

(2) In this Order “the Contractor” means Loughran Rock Industries (N.I.) Ltd. whose registered office is situated at 55 Friary Road, Cladybeg, County Armagh, BT60 2HE.

**Application**

**2.** The Contractor shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on completion of works the area of road described in the Schedule shall be abandoned.

**3.**—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road shall be retained.

## SCHEDULE

Article 2

### AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

An area of 5020 square metres of the U8133 (unnamed road) off Friary Road, Newtownhamilton commencing at its junction with the U8132 (unnamed road) and extending for a distance of 704 metres in a north-easterly direction more particularly delineated and shown coloured red on map number IN1/22/417994.

A copy of the map has been deposited at the Department's Headquarters, James House, The Gasworks, 2-4 Cromac Avenue, Belfast and at DfI Roads Southern Division, Marlborough House, Central Way, Craigavon.
