ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

The Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 5) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024

Made - - - - *12th November 2024*

Coming into operation *2nd December 2024*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 37(3), 37(4) and 38(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) (“the 1997 Order”) and now vested in it^(c).

In accordance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 5 to the 1997 Order, the Department has consulted such persons as it considers appropriate.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No objections were received.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Roads (Speed Limit) (No. 5) Order (Northern Ireland) 2024 and shall come into operation on 2nd December 2024.

(2) In this Order “Derry/Londonderry” means the City of Londonderry.

Speed restriction on certain roads

2. The Department directs that the speed limit on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 shall be a restricted road.

Application of speed limits

3. The driving of motor vehicles at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the roads specified in Schedule 2 is prohibited.

Revocations

4. The provisions described in Schedule 3 are revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

Article 2

Restricted length of road

Temple Road, Unclassified No. 1222, Derry/Londonderry, from its junction with Haw Road, Route C568, for a distance of 410 metres in a north-easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

Article 3

Roads and Lengths of road subject to a speed limit of 40 miles per hour

1. Tullyvar Road, Route A5, Aughnacloy, from a point 170 metres south-east of its junction with Favour Royal Road, Route B128, to a point 460 metres north of that junction.

2. Quarry Road, Route C550, Knockloughrim, Maghera, from a point 265 metres north-east of its junction with Hillhead Road, Route C557, to its junction with Ballynacross Road, Unclassified No. 5058.

3. Drumnagoon Road, Unclassified No. 1361, Portadown, for its entire length.

4. Kernan Hill Road, Unclassified No. 1361, Portadown, for its entire length.

5. Moy Road, Route B28, Scotch Street, Portadown, from a point 25 metres east of its junction with Drumanphy Road, Route C164, for a distance of 200 metres in an easterly direction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order—

- (a) makes the length of road specified in Schedule 1 a restricted road;
- (b) applies a speed limit of 40 miles per hour to the roads and lengths of road specified in Schedule 2; and
- (c) revokes the provisions in Schedule 3.

In relation to the revoked provisions in Schedule 3—

1. The speed limit on the length of Tullyvar Road, Aughnacloy (paragraph 1 of Schedule 3) is now included in a longer length of road set at 40 mph.

2. The speed limit on Kernan Hill Road and Drumnagoon Road, Portadown (paragraph 2 of Schedule 3) is now set at 40 mph.
