ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A835/A893 Trunk Road (Shore Street, Ullapool) (Special Event)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made *1st July 2011*

Coming into force *15th July 2011*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1), 2(2), 4(1) and 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 16A(2) of that Act they are satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of the Tall Ships celebration day 2011, and enabling members of the public to watch that event.

In accordance with section 16A(3) of that Act the Scottish Ministers are satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for that event to be held otherwise than on that length of road.

In accordance with section 16A(8) of that Act the Scottish Ministers have had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A835/A893 Trunk Road (Shore Street, Ullapool) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011, comes into force on 15th July 2011 and shall cease to have effect on 17th July 2011.

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991) Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by the Scotland Act 1998 (Consequential Modifications) Order 2001 (S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. Subject to article 3, no person shall use or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of traffic signs prescribed in diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a).

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

3. This Order does not apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance, or police purposes, or a vehicle while being used in connection with the placing of the required signage.

That length of the A835/A893 Tore - Ullapool Trunk Road known as Shore Street, Ullapool from its junction with Mill Street, Ullapool to its junction with Quay Street, Ullapool, a distance of 317 metres or thereby.
