ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A77 Trunk Road (Dalrymple Street, Girvan) (Special Event)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *23rd November 2011*

Coming into force - - *2nd December 2011*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1), and (2), and 4(1) and 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 16A(2) of that Act they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of the switching on of the Christmas lights and other associated entertainment and enabling members of the public to watch this event.

In accordance with section 16A(3) of that Act the Scottish Ministers are satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on that length of road.

In accordance with section 16A(8) of that Act the Scottish Ministers have had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A77 Trunk Road (Dalrymple Street, Girvan) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011, comes into force on 2nd December 2011 and ceases to have effect on 3rd December 2011.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. No person shall use or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of that length of road by means of traffic signs prescribed in diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

3. This Order does not apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance, or police purposes, or a vehicle while being used in connection with the holding of the switching on of the Christmas lights and associated entertainment.

SCHEDULE 1

Article 2

That length of the southbound A77 Glasgow - Stranraer Trunk Road known as Dalrymple Street, Girvan from its junction with Knockcushan Street, Girvan to its junction with Wesley Road, Girvan, a distance of 355 metres or thereby.
