The Poultry Health Scheme (Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2012

Made	29th May 2012
Laid before the Scottish Parliament	31st May 2012
Coming into force	1st July 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 56(1) and (2) of the Finance Act 1973(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation, commencement, extent and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations—
 - (a) may be cited as the Poultry Health Scheme (Fees) (Scotland) Regulations 2012;
 - (b) come into force on 1st July 2012; and
 - (c) extend to Scotland only.
- (2) In these Regulations, "the poultry health scheme" means the scheme for approval of establishments for the purposes of Council Directive 2009/158/EC on animal health conditions governing intra-Community trade in, and imports from third countries of, poultry and hatching eggs(b).

Fees relating to the poultry health scheme

2. The fee payable in respect of a matter under the poultry health scheme specified in an entry in column 1 of the following Table, is specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of that Table.
