ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A972 and A90 Trunk Roads (Kingsway Junction)
(Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turn) Order 2015**

Made - - - - 23rd February 2015

Coming into force - - 5th March 2015

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A972 and A90 Trunk Roads (Kingsway Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turn) Order 2015, comes into force on 5th March 2015 and ceases to have effect on 7th March 2015.

Prohibition of specified turns

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order so as to make the turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road by means of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagrams 612 and 613 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

Exemptions

3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes; or

Section 2(1) and (2) were amended by the New Road and Street Works Act 1991 (c.22) (“1991 Act”), paragraph 18 and section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), Schedule 1. The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the 1991 Act, Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

(b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

PART 1

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A92/A972 Kirkcaldy – Dundee Trunk Road known as Kingsway East, at its junction with the M90/A90 Edinburgh - Fraserburgh Trunk Road known as Forfar Road, Dundee.

PART 2

SPECIFIED TURN

The right turn at the traffic controlled junction from Kingsway East into Forfar Road.
