### ROAD TRAFFIC

The A77 Trunk Road (Ballantrae and Girvan) (Temporary Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2016

Made - - - - 15th February 2016

Coming into force - - 29th February 2016

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(b) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(b) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to works.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

#### Citation, commencement and cessation

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A77 Trunk Road (Ballantrae and Girvan) (Temporary Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 2016, comes into force on 29th February 2016 and ceases to have effect on 5th May 2016.

#### Prohibition on waiting, loading and unloading

**2.** No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle to wait, load or unload on the lengths of road, or a part or parts of the lengths of road, specified in the Schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to those lengths of road, or a part or parts of those lengths of road, by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagrams 636 and 636.1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(**b**).

**3.** No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes.

### **SCHEDULE**

Article 2

## SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

- **1.** That length of the M77/A77 Glasgow Stranraer Trunk Road being the northbound and southbound carriageway from a point at number 62 Main Street, Ballantrae to a point at number 76 Main Street, Ballantrae, a distance of 82 metres or thereby.
- **2.** That length of the M77/A77 Glasgow Stranraer Trunk Road being the southbound carriageway from a point at number 1 Dalrymple Street, Girvan to a point at number 14 Dalrymple Street, Girvan, a distance of 42 metres or thereby.
