ROAD TRAFFIC

The A9 Trunk Road (Upper Cairnie) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2016

Made - - - - - *7th July 2016*

Coming into force - - - - - *18th July 2016*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A9 Trunk Road (Upper Cairnie) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2016, comes into force on 18th July 2016 and ceases to have effect on 30th July 2016.

Prohibition of specified turns

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road by means of the traffic signs described in item 7 (diagram 612 – no right turn for vehicular traffic) and item 8 (diagram 613 – no left turn for vehicular traffic) of the sign table in Part 2 of schedule 3 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991, Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54) (relevantly amended by S.I. 2001/1400). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemptions

3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes; or
- (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

PART 1

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh – Stirling – Thurso Trunk Road between the Access Road off the unclassified road numbered the U50 by Dalreoch Bridge to Upper Cairnie, and the B934 Forteviot Junction, a distance of 0.110 kilometres or thereby.

PART 2

SPECIFIED TURNS

1. All right turns from the northbound deceleration lane in the central reservation to the B934 at the Forteviot Junction.
2. All right turns from the B934 at the Forteviot Junction crossing the central reservation heading northbound.
3. All right turns from southbound deceleration lane in the central reservation to the access road off the unclassified road numbered the U50 by Dalreoch Bridge to Upper Cairnie.
4. All right turns from the access road off the unclassified road numbered the U50 by Dalreoch Bridge to Upper Cairnie, crossing the central reservation and heading southbound.
