**The A83 Trunk Road (Furnace to Cumloden) (Temporary
40mph Speed Limit) Order 2016**

Made - - - - *27th July 2016*

Coming into force - - *8th August 2016*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 88(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 88(1) of that Act, they are satisfied that a temporary restriction of speed on the length of road specified in the schedule of this Order is desirable in the interests of safety. In accordance with section 88(1) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A83 Trunk Road (Furnace to Cumloden) (Temporary 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2016, comes into force on 8th August 2016 and ceases to have effect on 8th August 2017.

Temporary speed restriction

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the schedule of this Order at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour when a restriction is identified as applying to that length of road by means of a traffic sign of the type described in item 1 (diagram 670 maximum speed limit in mph) of the sign table in Part 2 of schedule 10 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016^(b).

Exemption

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A83 Tarbet - Lochgilphead - Campbeltown Trunk Road from a point 1.242 kilometres or thereby south west of the extended centre line of the junction with the C36 Furnace Side Road to a point 130 metres or thereby south west of the point where it meets the extended western gable wall of Number 1 Cumlodden Cottages a distance of 1.558 kilometres or thereby.
