**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A82 Trunk Road (Invergarry Swing Bridges) (Temporary Prohibition on Use and Width Restriction) Order 2016**

*Made* - - - - 29th December 2016

*Coming into force* - - 9th January 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Invergarry Swing Bridges) (Temporary Prohibition on Use and Width Restriction) Order 2016 comes into force on 9th January 2017 and ceases to have effect on 31st March 2017.

**Temporary restriction of use of vehicles**

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in the schedule if the width of the vehicle exceeds 3.5 metres, when such restriction is identified as applying to any part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign as prescribed by Diagram 629A of Part 2 of schedule 3 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

**Prohibition on use of vehicles**

3. No person may use or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road, specified in the schedule of this Order when a prohibition is identified as

applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of the traffic sign prescribed in item 8 (diagram 7105 – position of barrier to mark length of road closed or to guide traffic past an obstruction) in Part 6 of schedule 13 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>(a)</sup>.

#### **Exemptions**

**4.** No prohibition or restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes; or
- (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

## SCHEDULE

Article 2

### SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

**1.** That length of the A82 Dalnottar – Inverness Trunk Road from a point 335 metres or thereby south of its junction with Kilfinnan Road, Laggan northwards to a point 280 metres or thereby south of its junction with Kilfinnan Road, Laggan, a distance of 55 metres or thereby.

**2.** That length of the A82 Dalnottar – Inverness Trunk Road from a point 250 metres or thereby west of its junction with the access road leading to Aberchalder Farm, Invergarry, westwards to a point 310 metres or thereby west of its junction with the access road leading to Aberchalder Farm, a distance of 60 metres or thereby.
