ROAD TRAFFIC

The A82 Trunk Road (Invermoriston) (Temporary 40mph Speed Restriction) Order 2018

Made - - - - *18th October 2018*

Coming into force - - *29th October 2018*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the schedule should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

In accordance with section 15(2) of that Act, they are satisfied that the execution of the works will take longer than eighteen months and they will revoke this Order as soon as the works are complete.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Invermoriston) (Temporary 40mph Speed Restriction) Order 2018 and comes into force on 29 October 2018.

Speed restriction

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the lengths of road, or a part or parts of the lengths of road, specified in the schedule of this Order at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour when a restriction is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of a traffic sign of the type described in item 1 (diagram 670 – maximum speed limit in mph) of the sign table in Part 2 of schedule 10 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016^(b).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemption

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to –

- (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations; or
- (b) vehicles being used in an emergency for coastguard purposes.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

1. That length of the A82 Dallnottar – Inverness Trunk Road from a point 140 metres southeast of its junction with Dalcataig Road, Invermoriston in a generally south easterly and southwards direction to a point 1.1 kilometres south of the entrance to Loch Ness Highland Lodges, Invermoriston, a distance of 2.5 kilometres or thereby.
2. That length of the A82 Dallnottar – Inverness Trunk Road from a point 75 metres northeast of its junction with Bunoich Brae, Fort Augustus in a generally northeastwards direction to a point 700 metres northeast of its junction with the access to Alt na Criche, Fort Augustus, a distance of 2.6 kilometres or thereby.
