The disputed domain contains the complainant's well-known abbreviated name with no other distinguishing material. It is clearly intended to confuse members of the public into thinking that it is part of the complainant organisation and has all the hallmarks of being intended to be used for fraudulent email activity. Accordingly, it is an Abusive Registration under at least paragraph 5.1.2 of the DRS Policy.

## **8. Decision**

I grant the Complainant's application for a summary decision. In accordance with section 12 of the Policy, the domain name will therefore be transferred to the Complainant.
