**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND  
REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT**

1. By way of a letter dated 7 September 2015 the appellant's solicitors requested that the appeal be treated as withdrawn by the Upper Tribunal.
