

**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND  
REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT**

1. The appellant through his representatives requested leave to withdraw his appeal against the decision of the First-tier Tribunal which had dismissed his appeal in a determination promulgated on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2015. He was granted permission to appeal that decision on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2015.
2. Consent of the Upper Tribunal is required for a party to withdraw its case. Having considered the request by the appellant I give consent to her to withdraw her case.
3. Accordingly with my consent, and pursuant to rule 17(5) of the Tribunal Procedure (Upper Tribunal) Rules 2008, this appeal is recorded as "Withdrawn with the consent of the Upper Tribunal". This is a Notice pursuant to rule 17(5) to inform the parties that the appellant's case is withdrawn.
