DETERMINATION AND REASONS

- 1. The appellant appeals against a decision by First-tier Tribunal Judge S Gillespie, promulgated on 20 February 2017, dismissing his appeal against refusal of asylum.
- 2. The grounds include failure to make a finding on whether the appellant is a genuine Christian convert.
- 3. Mr Matthews conceded that the judge made no finding on the issue, and that the omission was an error of law.
- 4. The decision of the FtT is **set aside**. None of its findings are to stand, other than as a record of what was said at the hearing.

- 5. The nature of the case is such that it is appropriate in terms of section 12(2)(b)(i) of the 2007 Act and of Practice Statement 7.2 to **remit the case to the FtT** for an entirely fresh hearing.
- 6. The member(s) of the FtT chosen to consider the case are not to include Judge S Gillespie.
- 7. No anonymity direction has been requested or made.
